Call for Papers and Posters

Participants presenting papers or posters should complete and submit the registration form to Sasha Chisholm (sasha.chisholm@agr.gc.ca) **no later than October 16, 2024** and indicate the title and format (poster or paper) of their presentation. <u>Awards will be presented for best student and technician presentations (both oral and poster).</u>

Abstract Submission

Abstracts will be published in the conference proceedings. Additionally, participants are encouraged to submit abstracts for publication in the Canadian Journal of Plant Pathology (CJPP). All abstracts should be prepared according to the suggested CJPP format. For details regarding abstract formatting, please see the instructions for authors at:

Additional instruction for abstract preparation are found on page 5.

All abstracts must be reviewed by two colleagues knowledgeable in the area. The two reviewers should not be authors of the abstract. The authors should submit the final copy of their abstract(s) in electronic format to Sajid Rehman at: srehman@westerncropinnovations.com by **October 29, 2024** with the two reviewers' names indicated at the bottom.

For abstracts to be published in CJPP, a fee of \$35 must be paid at the time of registration. All abstracts must conform to the CJPP instructions, regardless of whether they are published in CJPP or not.

Paper Presentation Guidelines:

Oral presentations are allocated 12-15 minutes. Speakers should allow at least three minutes per presentation for questions/discussion. Presentations should be prepared using Microsoft PowerPoint.

Poster Presentation Guidelines:

Posters will be affixed to poster boards. Materials (e.g. poster boards, pins, sticky tac or Velcro tabs) will be provided. The maximum poster size is 90 cm (wide) x 120 cm (tall) and should be set up in 'portrait mode'. The poster heading should include title, author(s), affiliation and location. For clarity, lettering of heading, tables and figures should be readable from 1.5 to 2 m distance.



Abstract Format Submission to the Canadian Journal of Plant Pathology

Word processor

- Microsoft Word preferred and save the document as the doc file instead of the docx one.

Abstract font

- Times New Roman font and 12 point type preferred

Abstract title

- In bold, scientific names bold and italicised
- Only the first word of the title, proper names, and scientific names have the first letter capitalized

Author names

 In normal font, initial(s) first, followed by last name (e.g. A.B. Smith and C.B. Jones)

Affiliations

- In italics and need to include postal address and postal code (no abbreviations except for province or state names)
- First affiliation should be that of the first author. If other authors have different affiliations, those affiliations should start with the author's initials, e.g. (C.B.J.)

Abstract body

- In normal font with scientific names italicised
- The maximum number of words for each abstract is 250, not including the title, author(s) and affiliation(s).
- Scientific authorities are to be given for all scientific names the first time they are mentioned in the body of the abstract
- Abbreviations, nomenclature, symbols for units of measurements, etc. are to conform to the requirements for manuscripts submitted to CJPP

At the bottom of the abstract clearly indicate the following:

 Names of two people other than the authors who have critically reviewed the abstract. When the abstracts are compiled for publication in CJPP, the reviewer information will be omitted

Abstract fee:

- There is a \$35 fee for each abstract to be published in CJPP which will be due at the time of registration.
